### Holiday Tots Top Ten

**Puy du Fou.** A great medieval day out for all the family. With superb falconry displays, jousting tournaments, chariot races and dancing fountains. Feast on bread freshly baked in medieval ovens. Great website. At Les Herbiers. 45 miles, 1hr.

**Zoodyssée de Chizé.** Animals in their natural environment. With otters, vultures, wolves, cicadas, tree frogs and more. With mini farm and play area. At Villiers-en-bois. 47 miles, 1hr.

**Forêt de Mervent.** Lovely woodland with a small zoo, 2 mini farms for close animal encounters and an amusement park *Le Parc de Pierre Brune*. At Mervent. 23 miles, 35 minutes.

**Le Petit Train Pibalou.** Take a 50 minute ride by scenic railway. Alternatively travel the country roads by horse-drawn carriage. At Coulon. 26 miles, 45 minutes.

**Le Jardin des Chirons.** The 'garden of rocks' an enchanting leafy valley where elves, pixies and giants sit on enormous mushroom-shaped granite boulders...don't miss the enormous **Rocher Branlant** or 'rocking boulder'...At Largeasse. 4 miles, 10 minutes.

**Coulon.** One of the **plus beaux villages de France**. An irresistibly photogenic little town from which to hire a punt and gently navigate through the water playground of the Marais Poitevin. Look out for otters! At Coulon. 26 miles, 45 minutes.

**Parc Ornithologique et Embarcadère.** See diverse birdlife by boat including ducks, geese, swans and herons. Life jackets provided for children. Or take a picnic and stroll around the pushchair-friendly pathways. At St Hilaire La Palud. 36 miles, 1hr.

**Pescalis.** Nature and fishing centre. With an aquarium, playground and pony rides. Bicycle rental : child seats and helmets available. At Moncoutant. 10 miles, 15 minutes.

**Mouton Village.** Walk amongst the gentle sheep and marvel at the sheep-shearing demonstrations and sheep dogs at work. At Vasles. 31 miles, 48 minutes.

**Lac de Lambon.** A large, inland lake with a sandy beach, watersports, children's play area and little train. Pushchair-friendly path all around lake. At Prailles. 32 miles, 48 minutes..
